

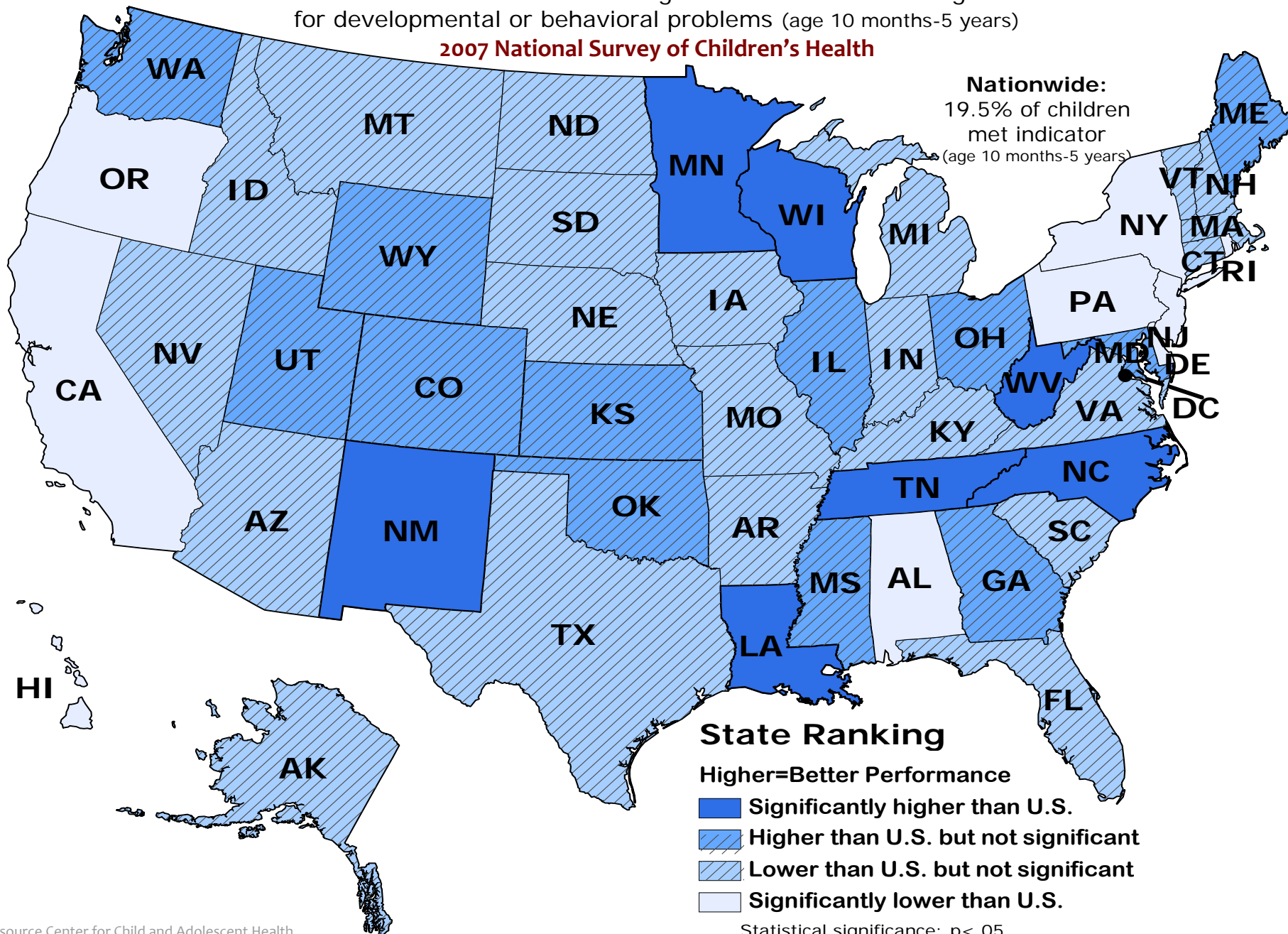


### Developmental Screening
